FPCA BOARD MEETING MINUTES

BOARD MEETING NOVEMBER 13, 2007

The meeting was called to order by President, Dave Paul, at 7:10 at the Epworth Methodist Church. Board members attending were Dave Paul, Carol Overfield, Arline Ries, Dick Buttermore, Mike Stone, Bob Hinebaugh, JoAnn Jeck, Kit Race, Lyn Denney and George Schmidt. Excused was Carol Pence.

George Schmidt made a motion to accept the minutes from our last meeting. It was seconded by Mike Stone and approved by all.

Dave Paul gave the President's report. A contract for a 161 special improvement district was approved by Northland Alliance. There have been on going cleanups for 161 and Cleveland Ave. There was a good turn out for candidates' night last month. Dockside Dolls appealed the suspension of their liquor license. A judge granted a stay and they will go to court again in January. The 2012 Commission is a group of 13 focus groups to define the needs of the community. A bond issue will be on the ballot next November to pay for their ideas. The 161 Task Force has created a business block watch for 161.

Dick Buttermore made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report. It was seconded by Mike Stone and approved by all.

The new budget for 2008 was approved as written. George Schmidt will chair a social activities committee.

Mike Hammel, owner of apartments on Arborwood, is concerned about crime in his area. He wants security to patrol this area.

Sequoia Bowling has been cited for the banner they have displayed on the side of the building.

We have collected \$19,215 for membership this year. That is 33.4% of the residents.

Arline says she needs articles to put in the Forester. There are a lot of areas not getting The Forester. George will investigate other ways to deliver it.

Lyn Denny had a NCC handout from the Sierra Club on how to curb global warming.

Mike Stone reported that the development committee is working with Menards on the graphics for Northland Village.

The civic action report was given by Dick Buttermore. Problem with moving van in driveway on Redwood blocking the sidewalk. High grass at Cherrywood and Yellowwood. A tractor trailer in the Sandalwood Shopping Center.

Detective Atwood made a report about the Hispanic gangs at the last block watch meeting.

There was a lengthy discussion about excluding area 13 from Forest Park. We have only had 2 residents pay for membership the last couple of years. We have the expense of sending membership applications and delivering the Forester. It was suggested we not send the Forester. We didn't have enough board members present for a vote so was tabled until our next meeting.

We adjourned at 9:25.
