## FOREST PARK BLOCK WATCH PROGRAM

Last month I brought us up to date about the Block Watch program. I now want to expand on the program and how each of us can help. It takes neither a lot of time nor money. It does take a little concern and interest in our community and the people around us. I explained the program is about neighbors that care about maintaining a secure and peaceful community in which to live. That means knowing your neighbors and talking to them concerning things they have seen or heard about unusual activities from their viewpoint. This is not to encourage a Kumbaya moment or establishing a permanent relationship but creating a line of communication. In that way information can be distributed to all. There are many benefits to be gained that may not be readily evident.

For example: In April last an individual came to my door on Loganwood Rd at around 9:30 PM stating he worked for H.H. Gregg, lived nearby, and only had a half tank of gas. He explained his mother was being operated on in Detroit for a brain tumor and he needed money for gas to get there. I told him he had better get out of the neighborhood quickly as I was in the process of calling the police and I had cell phone in hand. He hurried to his car and drove away. A couple of days later I mentioned this to my neighbor across the street who advised the guy had come to the their house first but as they had no cash and knew I had a small supply of gasoline they referred him to my house. A few weeks passed and I again mentioned this to another neighbor about a block away on Loganwood and found this had happened to them as well but at 6:00 AM. Then, in May a resident of Sharon Woods contacted Forest Park Civic Association, at the recommendation of a police officer, to report a 6:00 AM attempt and I just learned of a like incident on Hazelwood, this time at 5:00 AM. These are only the incidents I KNOW about.

The individual was not threatening in any manner and in each case mentioned H.H. Gregg, occasionally wears an H.H. Gregg jacket and claims to live nearby at a location that is completely false; to me he claimed he lived on the corner of Firwood and Karl (they do not intersect), in two cases he gave a house number that cannot exist, and his mother is either in a hospital in Chillicothe, Cleveland, Detroit, or simply 270 miles away. He is about 5'10", 210-200 pounds, a white male, 50-55 years old and casually dressed. In my case he drove a dark colored mid 80's GM full size 4- door sedan parked in the street but since it was dark, I couldn't get a license number. A few have given him small amounts of money so he is sure to continue his con game.

The points I am making are: Had there been an prior alert system to spread the word around the neighborhood someone could have gotten a license number. While the guy does not appear to be a physical threat we do not need to broadcast to the crooks that we are easy targets. And always CALL THE POLICE or at least let me know. There is no need to wait for an officer to make a formal report as to them this would be a low priority incident. You usually can remain anonymous. We need to make the Police Department aware and could lead to the apprehension of this guy. This pertains to all beggars. Lastly, since we are not all connected to the Internet, those of us who are need to speak for the neighbors who are not. See something - Say something.

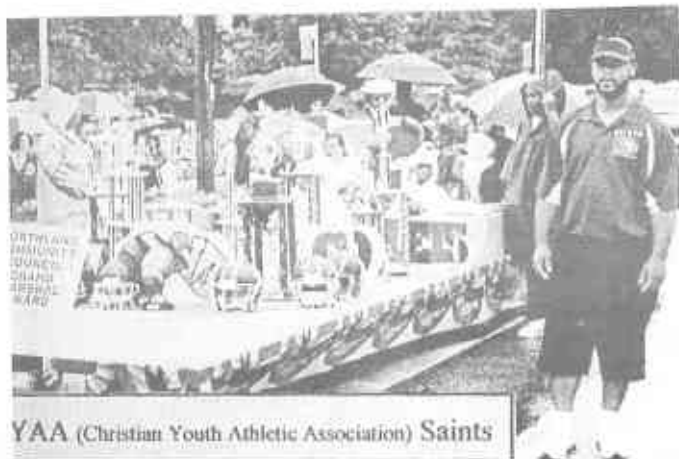

The 2008-2009 Forest Park Civic Association Membership Drive is underway.

We began in late April with a mailing to nearly 3,000 Forest Park households. This mailing included information on the Forest Park Civic Association's many activities on behalf of our community, along with your Household Data Sheet which lists the information currently in our membership database for your household. It also included a Volunteer Sheet and descriptions of many activities and events for which Forest Park residents can volunteer, helping us keep our community one of the best places to live in Columbus.

If you haven't already done so, please return your Household Data Sheet today in the supplied envelope. We hope, of course that you'll support the Association, and help us expand our efforts during the next year, by returning your \$20.00 membership dues with your Data Sheet, and perhaps by volunteering for one or more activities. As a non-profit, all volunteer organization, we exist purely because of those who care enough to commit their personal time and effort to our community. Our funding is exclusively through membership dues, newsletter advertising and the very modest revenue earned during some of our events.

Didn't join in 2007? Please consider doing so this year. New members during this year's drive will receive the latest edition of The Forest Park Directory. In its 150 pages, you'll

fine helpful information about our community, and telephone numbers for city services.

Returning your forms now will be a great help to us, even if you decide not to join. If we don't receive your Data Sheet by mail, your neighborhood section representative, (a.k.a. block captain) will need to stop by to visit you in August to confirm that we still have the correct information for your household and inquire about your household and inquire about your interest in Association membership

We currently have fewer than the 260 volunteer Section Representatives that would be ideal to visit the almost 3,000 households in Forest Park, so this entails significant time and effort for FPCA Area and Section Representatives -- your neighbors -- who devote their summer evenings and weekends to do this task. By returning your form and/or dues by mail, you'll eliminate the need for a visit to your household by an FPCA Representative, and any potential inconvenience to you.

WHY: Shoppers will find in-season produce including sweet corn, potatoes, cucumbers, and tomatoes, as well as unique items like Asian greens, edamame, and more. Annual herbs and flowers, including cut and dried arrangements potted plants, and perennials also may be found. Other items typically featured include jams and jellies, honey and syrup products, garlic, fruit and herb vinegars, hot peppers, Indian corn, summer squash, pumpkins and gourds. Organic beef and cheese products also may be available.

### FOR-MEL WOMAN'S CLUB

There have been some questions as to the naming of the For-Mel Woman's Club which organized in April 1962. At that time the Forest Park, Woodward Park and Kar-Mel Village areas were beginning and the young married were purchasing their new homes. There was an abundance of youngsters and many stay at home mothers at the time. Naturally wanting some 'space' time for themselves they began a movement to have a reason to get out at night, so after dinner was over and children ready for bed a group of women began meeting in their homes to get acquainted. Meetings were in the homes on rotating basis with two or three hostesses. Soon the group affiliated with the Junior Woman's Club of Ohio (later to the Woman's Club of Ohio and later still became Unaffiliated). Various speakers of interest to the young woman spoke at the meetings on timely interests: Schools, Legislature, City officers including Police and Fire, Medical information, gardening, just about anything the membership had an interest in. At one time there were over 70 members with a waiting list and eventually larger meeting places were needed, including bank and church meeting rooms. In the 70's it was decided to begin the For-Mel Bridge Marathon with monies earned dedicated to a High School Scholarship for a local high school i.e.; Beechcroft, Northland, Brookhaven and St. Francis DeSales. This marathon has distributed over \$7,000 to those schools to date. For-Mel also has donated to many charities and organizations including the Columbus Zoo, Ronald McDonald House, Choices, Interplast, World Church Service and the like. Over the years membership has dropped to 14 women, still active in community work and volunteerism and still meeting monthly although most do not reside in the Northland Area. 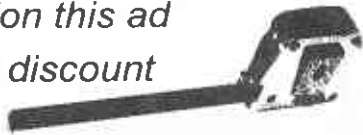

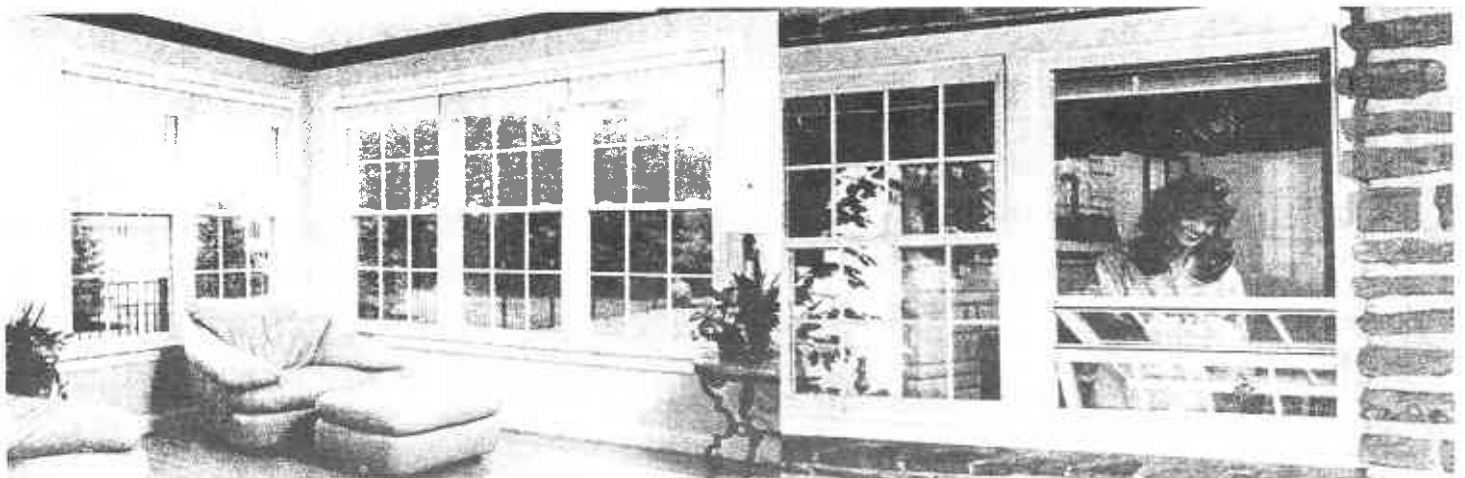

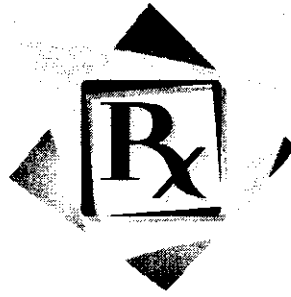
