FOREST PARK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL NEWS

Forest Park Elementary School opened this school year with over 380 students and is continuing to grow. "That is one reason for the modular unit on the south side of the school. This unit will also allow the library to return to its full space, much to the delight of students and the librarian, Mrs. Brooks," explains Mrs. Rhonna McKibben, principal. The modular unit is accommodating the fourth grade science and math classes taught by Mrs. Carla Davis.

Two new teachers joined the staff: John Thomas and Danielle Smith, both teaching fifth grade. Other teachers changing their grade level: John Kountz from first to third, Miss Kennette Edwards and Mrs. Kasha Calloway from third to second, and Mrs. Erma Britford from second to third.

The school has plans in place for all kinds of possible emergencies, from fire to unknown intruders. Each month a fire drill is held as well as a drill for another kind of emergency so that the children and staff are well prepared. The evacuation drill used for an actual fire or bomb threat includes walking all of the children to a safe alternate site, Woodward Park Middle School. Another drill practices getting the children back into the school quickly. "The Columbus Public School System takes every step possible to keep the children safe," says Mrs. McKibben.

Parents picking up their children after school have two alternative parking locations: for primary students, stop on Ironwood near the walkway; for intermediate students, park on Cherrywood Rd. on the west side of the school. If your family includes both age groups, use the Cherrywood Rd. pickup.

Area residents are urged to drive carefully during arrival times (school starts at 9 a.m. this year) and dismissal times. (3:30 p.m. this year)

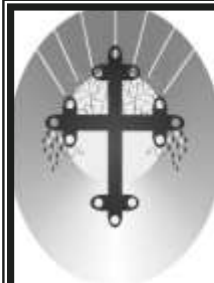



NORTH SIDE HEALTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE

If you care about the health of the community this might be for you. Director of Community Health, John Tolbert, was in the North end August 12 with some very exciting news about forming the North side Health Advisory Board. We are looking for co-chairs for this effort. It will take a big effort, but the rewards will be great.

Folks from the south, east and west who have already begun were at the meeting and shared what they have accomplished. It was inspiring to see the enthusiasm and elevated sense of accomplishment these people displayed. On the east side the community discovered the number one problem was diabetes. There was not one grocery store in the 2 zip codes. People did not have access to good fresh food.

When a grocer moved in, their committee was able to negotiate with them to enlarge the fresh produce section and have many more amenities that lead to good eating. At the same time there was a concerted effort to bring in exercise programs. Each area had similar stories. Similar in that it was the local community that decided the areas on which to work and implemented the program.

The City will give resources so that we can see the demographics of the health of the Northland area. They will assist by telling us what is available in our area and from government to help. Basically this is a neighborhood deciding what we want the city to do. We then carry out the program.

Even if you are not considering being a co-chair, you need to be aware of the Health Advisory Committee. As a bonus, this group will help us to be able to respond to health emergencies. You all know that we may be faced with the potential of one with the H1N1 virus. We can be the key to keeping this from becoming an epidemic.

Stay tuned for more information. A great way to help with the problems of the healthcare system is to do all we can to stay healthy.
