

FOREST PARK CIVIC ASSOCIATION GENERAL MEETING FEBRUARY 8, 2011 By Carol Overfield

The meeting was called to order by Vice President, Dave Paul, at 7:00 at the Epworth Methodist Church. The minutes were presented from our last meeting. They were approved.

The Treasurer's report was given by Dan Hartzell. It was approved as presented.

Mike Stone presented the nominations for officers and representatives for 2011. There were no further nominations from the floor. All nominations were elected unanimously.

Our goals for 2011 were discussed at an executive meeting last month. Some of those included updating the website, delivery system for the Forester, improve the membership drive blitz, senior events, and a float for the 4th of July parade.

Some issues from the community were:

- Dockside Dolls opening under a new name.
- The cell tower on Tamarack Circle at the carwash which is now bank owned.
- Kohls is closing February 26.
- Menards is opening April 12.
- Pot holes and weeds behind Telhio at Northland Village.
- Try to get the city to take care of the ice on the roads.

An officer from US Protection gave a presentation on security. Dave Paul announced that 848 joined the civic association last year. That is less than 30%.

The 50th anniversary edition of the Forester will be delivered this coming weekend. The deadline for next month's issue is February 17.

Dave Paul said NCC is trying to re-define Northland and to improve their image. Their next meeting will be Thursday when they will have elections. The banquet will be in April or May.

City Attorney Pfeiffer will be at the next Block watch meeting in 2 weeks.

Look how few and tiny trees are on Poplarwood in mid to late 1960's




Y News


