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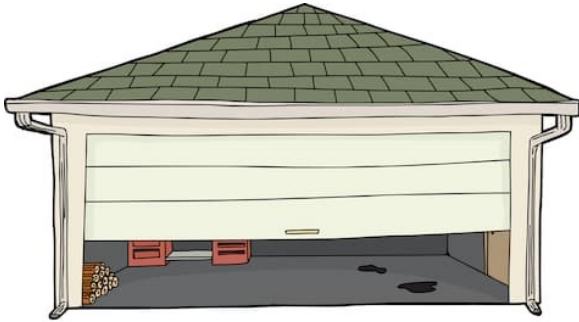
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# Supplemental Security News

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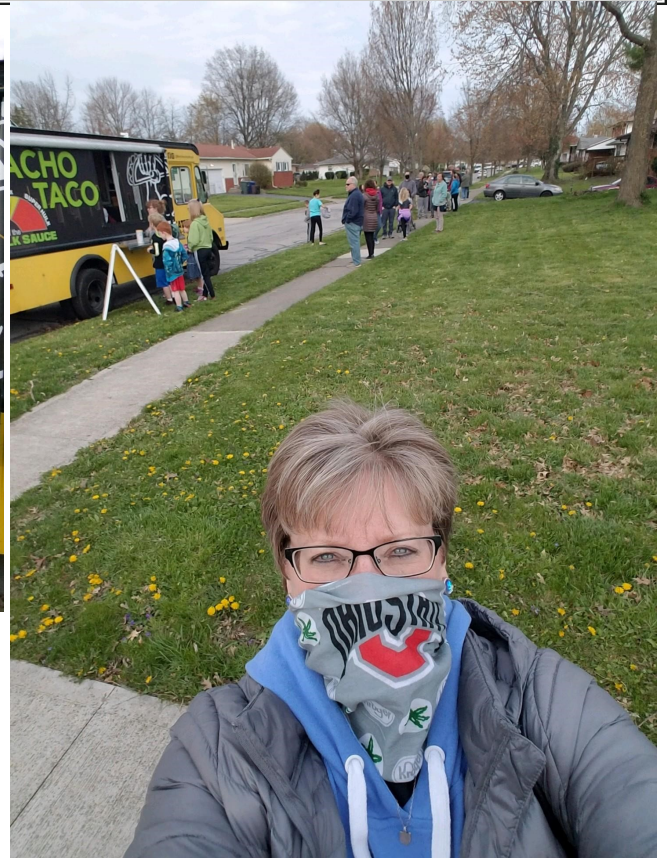

3. **Wipes:** Baby wipes, "disposable/flushable" wipes, personal hygiene wipes, and cleaning wipes
4. **Cooking Oil/Grease:** Fats, oils, cooking grease - used or unused
5. **Grease:** Auto, industrial
6. **Cloth:** Cleaning rags, nylon stockings, underwear, shop towels, mop heads, dental floss
7. **Plastic:** Plastic bags, plastic cotton swabs, disposable lighters, hotel shampoo bottles

1. Welcomed all to the 1st Zoom meeting. When will we go back to normal FPCA business? We will follow Gov. DeWine’s guidelines. We are shooting for mid-May to send out the membership mailers to everyone.
2. We are going to have a remote stuffing for the membership envelopes with volunteers stuffing them in their houses. This is an important way to help people stay connected.
3. Next month, May, will have an online *Forester* only. June *Forester* will be printed and included in the membership packet. Stuffing must be done by May 23rd, so there is time to get them to the people who will be taking them all to the post office. There are approximately 3000 membership envelopes to stuff and mail.

1. March membership: 6 new members. Membership totals for the end of Mar. out of 2800+ households (year) : 572 (2020), 590 (2019) and 630 (2018)
2. The budget was accepted and passed. See budget in this month’s *Forester*.
3. We are ahead of budget for the year, especially because we are saving money on printing and delivering the *Forester* for 2 months. Therefore there is plenty of money for Mary and Rita’s proposal for \$\$ for lunch for the workers at Oakleaf village. (See Rita’s proposal below.)
